



Transform Lexington Market Vendor Category Details

- Great Public Markets have a wide variety of vendors and products to appeal to diverse customers and to deliver an excellent shopping experience. The following document is an explanation of the vendor types and product categories that will and will not be part of the New Lexington Market.
- It is Lexington Market's goal to maintain affordable options in the market across vendor types, and vendors' prices will be considered in the application process.
- Some vendor applicants may have business concepts that cross between the categories below. Please apply in the category that makes up the majority of your business. Your rent may adjusted based on your product selection and sales.
- No more than 2 of any duplicate business will be accepted into the market, though product offerings may be offered by more than 2 vendors. For example, there would be no more than 2 delis, but other vendors may sell sandwiches.

Fresh

Definition: Sells fresh produce, meat, fish, dairy, fish, dry goods and/or accompanying items, most or all for customers to take home.

Specialty Food & Retail

Definition: Sells value-added food or food-related products or services, which may be for consumption on site or for customers to take home.

Example Vendors:

Candy/Fudge	Coffee (Beans and/or Hot)	Regional Specialty Food

Prepared Food

Definition: Prepared food for carry out and/or consumption on site. Can be hot or cold. Prepared food vendors who do not need a hood may apply for Specialty Food stalls.

Example Vendors:

Kiosks

Kiosks are small vendor stalls (less than 150 sf) which are pre-built and allow for some customization and signage. They could be suitable for any product type, provided it can be made and/or sold in the space provided. Some kiosks can be rented on a short-term basis.

Alcohol

There will be no vendor in Lexington Market selling only alcohol, such as a bar, but a small number of vendors will be given additional permission to sell alcohol for on premises consumption. The details of permitting and license fees are being formulated and are not yet available, but will be published when they are.
